City of Refuge, Jamaica

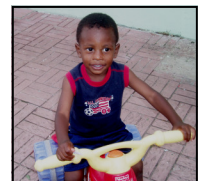
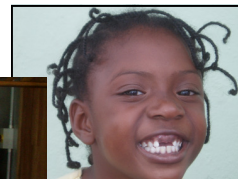
